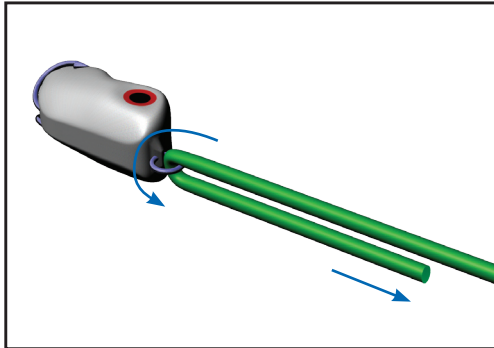
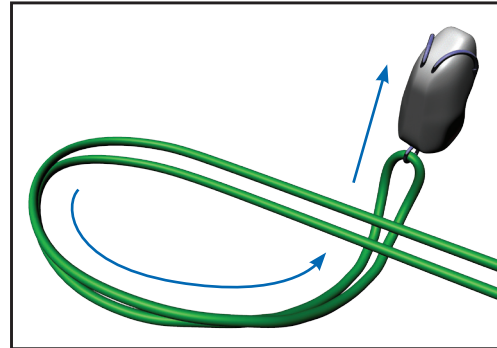


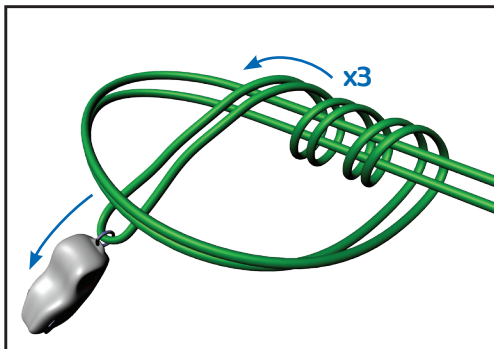
Braided Loop Knot



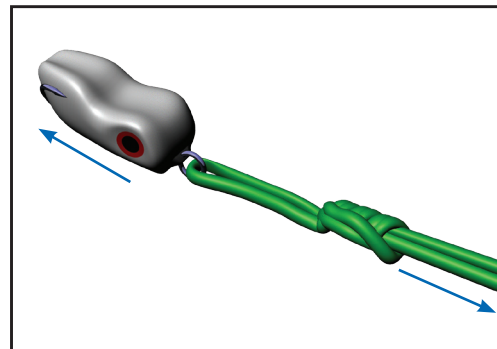
Step 1 Feed the tag end through the eye of the hook or lure.



Step 2 Form an underhand loop under the two standing lines with the lure.



Step 3 Loop the the lure through the loop three times.



Step 4 Lubricate the line. Pull on the lure and the line to tighten the knot.

Uses: This knot is a good choice when using a nylon line. Nylon fishing line cannot take an angular pull for very long without fatiguing, and eventually breaking over time. A double line configuration greatly adds overall strength.

Tying it: When properly tied these braided fishing line knots are certainly the best looking of the braided fishing line knots and is very strong.

Advantages: This knot is unbelievably easy to tie and tests at 90% of the line strength.
